What I have learned these past two years when children make their first time commitment to Jesus Christ at our programs that 71% of the children have never been in church and they heard for the first time that Jesus Christ is not a name used for offensive language. Jesus became their Savior! It blows me away knowing what is happening in the lives of children. Once making that decision they face the home front what will mom and dad think of me. The talks I had with children and teenagers this past summer would take me pages to tell you about their lives but leaving each one of them with an assurance that the decision they made no one can take it away.

I see and hear not only children hurting but adults dealing with life issues that are crippling them in their heart. Witnessing people that question is God hearing my prayers? Giving excuses why they are not worshiping on Sunday's to men dealing with many issues. The devil has a stronghold on lives that doubt and fear that keep people from the perfect love God gave us through Jesus Christ. God's word in 1 John 4:18 says, *There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love.* If we take this verse to heart and realize He overcomes everything with His perfect love and being in love with Jesus drives out fear. Where does your relationship stand? One that fears or one perfect in love with the Savior?

I believe God is calling each of us to a higher calling. In order to know what that higher calling is we must seek Him daily through worship, scripture and prayer. Please pray for the higher calling God is placing upon the ministry and all God has ready for CSI in 2011.

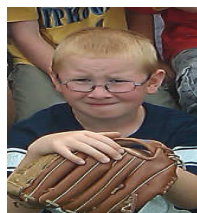
